Date: 15-06-2026

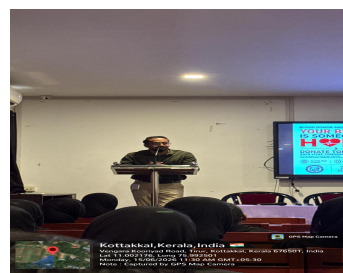
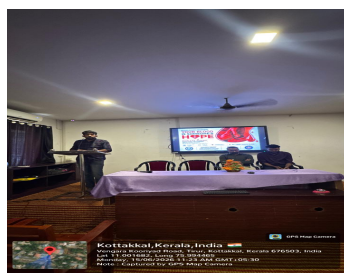
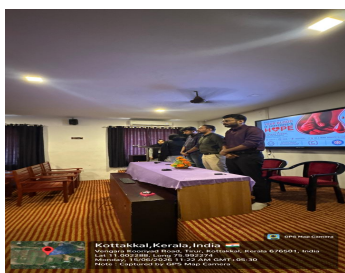

BLOOD DONATION CAMP

NSS Unit 213 of Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College, in association with the Blood Donors Kerala (BDK) Tirurangadi Taluk Committee and the Government Blood Centre, Manjeri, organised a Blood Donation Camp on 30 June 2026 at the college campus. The programme was conducted from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. with the objective of promoting voluntary blood donation, creating awareness about the importance of donating blood, and fostering humanitarian values among students and the community. OBSERVATION OF INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING

In alignment with the national vision of the Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan and in observance of the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit 213 of Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College, in formal collaboration with the District Administration, Malappuram and the District Social Justice Office, Malappuram (Government of Kerala), organized an Anti-Drug Awareness Quiz and Essay Writing Competition on 01 July 2026. The primary objectives of this joint initiative were to systematically educate and sensitize the student community regarding the severe physical, psychological, and socio-economic hazards of substance abuse, to foster critical thinking among the youth regarding their role in eradicating the drug menace, and to empower them to act as proactive ambassadors for healthy, drug-free lifestyles within society.

The campaign commenced at 11:00 AM with the Quiz Competition, which saw active engagement from 81 students. Com Taxation) taking the Third Prize. The winners were awarded with cash prizes.
